## Two BMFC Members compete in the top FAI schedule

On Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> May 2019, 2 BMFC members competed in the GBRCAA National League at Warboys in the FAI schedule. This is a record! The pilots were Mark Allen and Peter Jenkins. This was Mark's first competition flying the FAI schedule while this was Peter's 6<sup>th</sup> year.

Mark was flying a Spark EVO which he flew last year in the Masters schedule and, having gained promotion points, has moved up to FAI this year. The model is powered by a Hacker C50-13XL motor turning a single 2 blade prop. He has spent much time in trimming the aircraft over the past few months and so his practice of the schedule has been limited. Peter was flying a BJ Craft Agenda which he also flew last year. The Agenda is powered by a Leomotion motor driving a CRS contra Gearbox driving 2 counter rotating propellers. Peter's practice time has also been limited this year.

There were 17 entrants across 4 classes. In FAI, there were 7 entrants. All competitors had 3 flights with the scores from the best 2 being added together and then ranked. Mark's lack of practice was a factor and although he recorded some good scores he was not consistent enough across the whole schedule. He was placed 7<sup>th</sup>. Peter gained his best position ever by taking 2<sup>nd</sup> place.
