

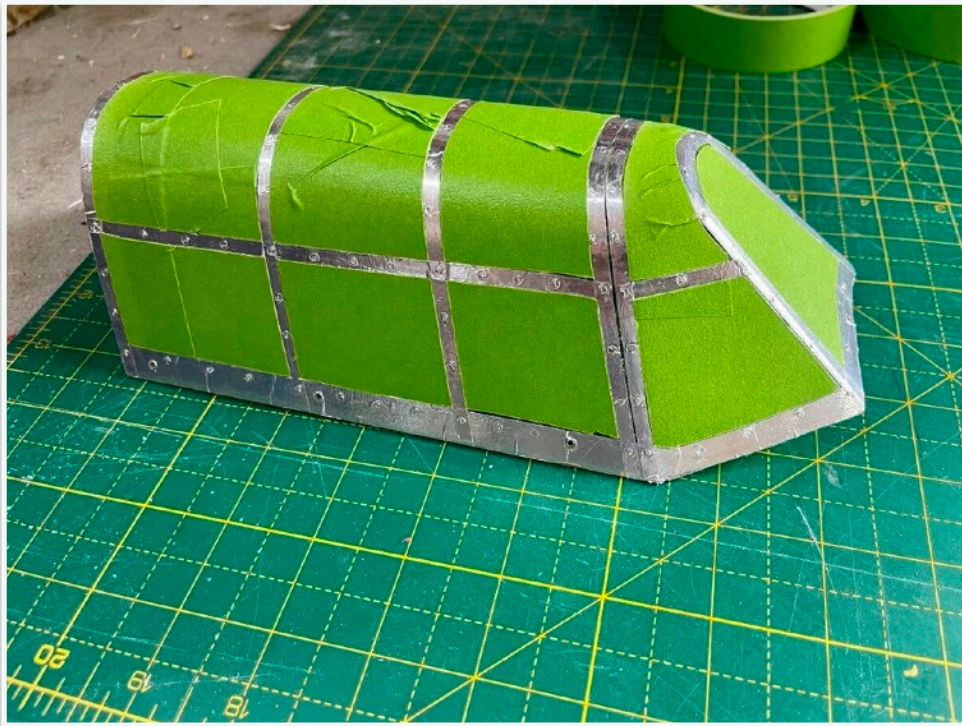
YT (ESM) Hurricane Refurb,

Part 4

I thought that I'd better make a start on the canopy. A couple of months ago I ordered one for an 88" Hurricane from Sarik which, after much chopping, fits quite well. So I added some aluminium tape for the canopy frame.



Then formed the screw heads and masked it all up in readiness for paint.

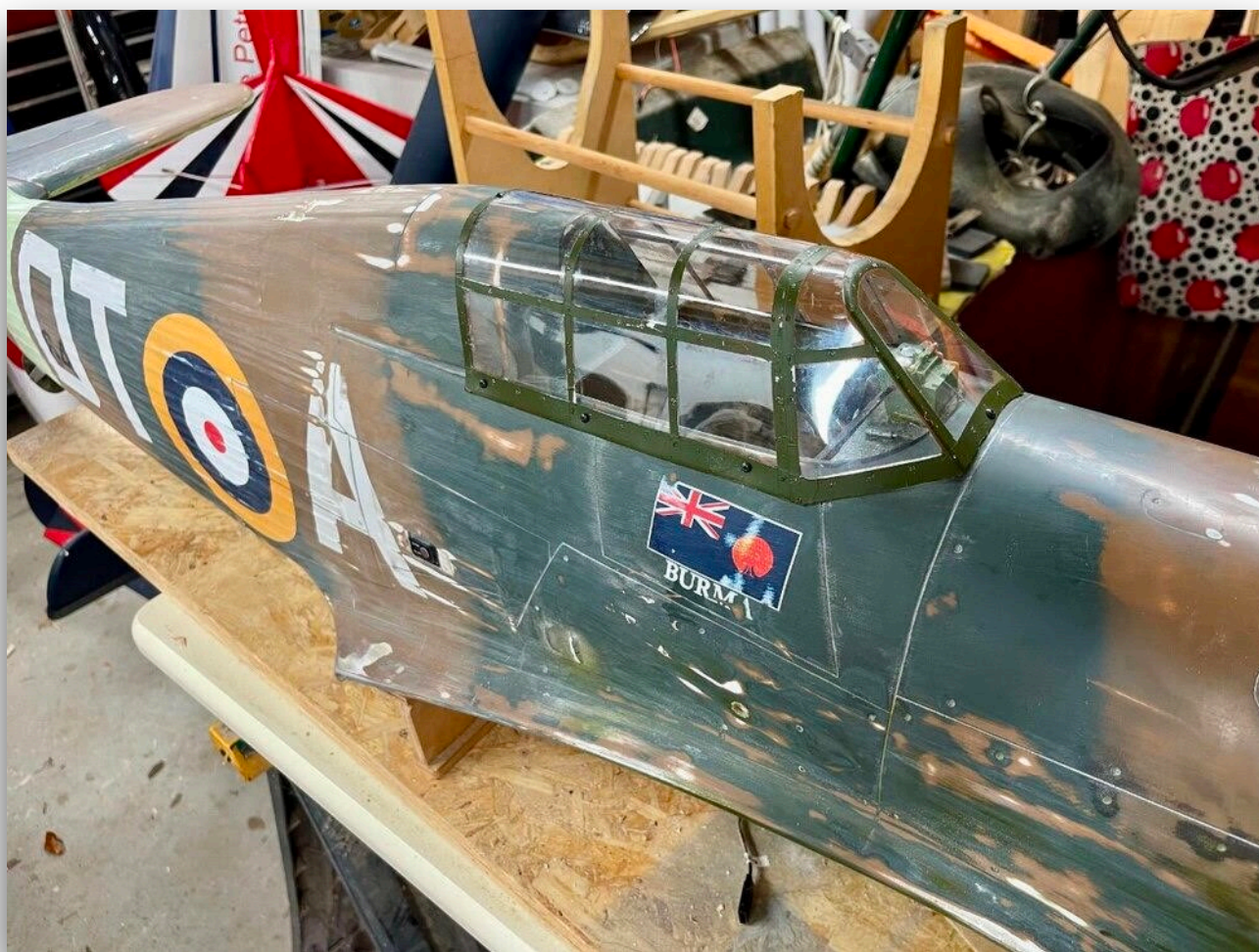


TBH I haven't spent a lot of time on this as it's going to be redone at a later date because I want to cut the canopy and make it sliding. But it will do for now.



A bit of paint makes all the difference

Looks OK apart from the door panel doesn't line up due to the scale of the canopy! So I'll either ignore it or fill in the door panel lines and redo them in the new position.



Having got that bit done it was time to get back onto the cowl which was filled (P38) and sanded.



Holes cut for front pot and needle but you can see why I want to convert it to the tropical variant as the Vokes filter will not only cover the front pot but it will give me chance to sort some cool air ducting for the rear pot.
