

YT (ESM) Hurricane Refurb, Part 5


Plumbing all done.




Couldn't resist putting it all together! I took the opportunity to use my Vanessa balancing rig the result being that I needed 500g of lead in the nose to get the correct C of G! This was initially zip tied to the motor.



A few people thought that the zip tie arrangement to hold the lead in place might be tempting fate, so I changed it to a more positive fixing. This was the initial fabrication and I still needed to turn the hex bar down to make to look a bit less Frankenstein.



After machining it looks a bit better plus with the through bolts it gives me scope to have differing balance weights to put in place if I find this one to be less than ideal..
